

FAHPERDS Awards: Defined

Procedure: Go to www.fahperd.org, click on 'awards' on the left side of the opening page, see the different awards as noted below and nominate a person or program. The application will be sent to the person by the chair of the committee for that award.

Peter Everett Honor Award

FAHPERDS' most prestigious award, the Peter Everett Honor Award, is bestowed in recognition of outstanding professional contributions to FAHPERDS professions. Normally awarded to a long term FAHPERDS member who has served at several levels - local, state and district and/or nationally. Meritorious service and distinctive leadership are two important criteria for consideration for this award. No more than two (2) such awards may be awarded each year.

The Honorary Life Membership

May be awarded to retired professionals in HPERDS who have served FAHPERDS and the profession with excellence and distinction over an extended period of time.

Educator of the Year

Awarded annually, to an exemplary teacher/educator in Physical Education, Health, Dance, Sport, College/University and District Administration (CODA). Districts and local associations are encouraged to submit nominations each year. Association committees select the Educator of the year for their respective association.

Program Recognition (title changed from 'Professional to Program' in Spring 2008)

Awarded annually to unique and innovative **programs** in Physical Education, Health, Dance, Educational Leadership and Sport (**not to individual persons**).

Student of the Year

The Educational Leadership Association honors a FAHPERDS student member each year. Criteria include scholarship, service to the school, community and profession. College professors or others familiar with the students' academic and service activities make these nominations.

Community Service

The community service award may be given to an organization, individual or media group for contributions and service to health and wellness issues related to FAHPERD disciplines.

***Katherine Montgomery Scholar**

The Katherine Montgomery Scholar Committee recruits nominations and selects annual recipients of the scholarship, a monetary award, each year. Junior colleges, college and universities may nominate students in FAHPERDS disciplines for this award.

Students must be enrolled as a full time junior or senior student with a major in HPER at an accredited institution. [***This award is NOT conducted through the online process. This award is handled by the Katherine Montgomery Scholar Committee in concert with the HPERDS faculty members of the colleges and universities in Florida.**]

NOTE:

*The award nomination process is an **online process only**. Members may go to www.fahperd.org to access the online process and nominate other members. Any member may nominate any other member for any award. Self-nomination is not permitted and is not accepted. Award recipients are recognized at the Annual Conference Awards General Session (and again at the Friday Night All-Conference Social) and in the Winter FAHPERDS Journal. All award recipients must be FAHPERDS members, except for the Community Service Award. (In Spring 2008 the Board voted to end the practice of self-nomination for FAHPERDS Awards)*
